

February Outdoor Activities

Five Hundred

Age Range: 3rd grade – 6th Grade

Supplies: Gaga ball, pen and paper or white board & markers.

Set Up: None

<u>Instructions</u>: One person is the thrower and stands at one end of the playing field. Everyone else waits at the other end of the play area. The thrower tosses the ball in the air towards everyone else and announces a number between 50 and 200. If a kid catches the ball they get as many points as the thrower yelled. If the ball is missed or dropped, that person loses the same number of points (negative score is possible). The first person to get 500 points wins and becomes the thrower for the next game. If the children cannot remember their points, use the white board and markers to keep track of the score.
