Age Range: All ages

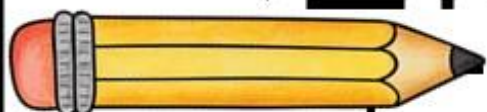
Supplies: All about me template (attached)

Instructions: Have each child decorate their own All About Me Poster. Once they have completed have them share with the rest of the students. Hang the posters in your room for the rest of the month.

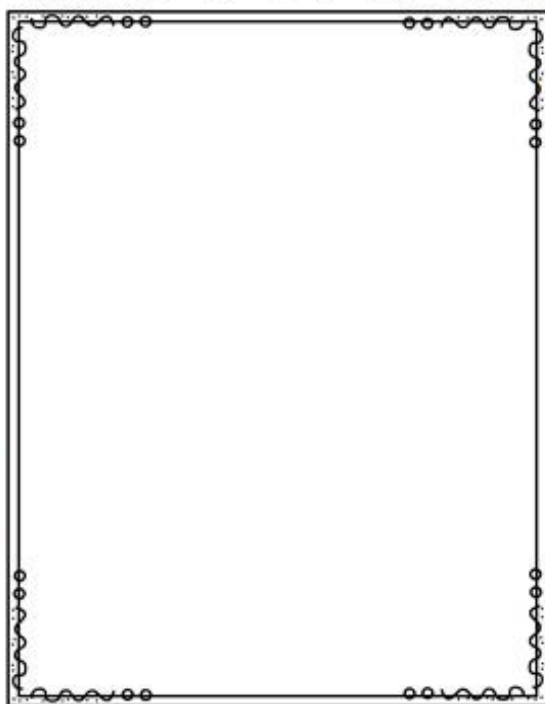

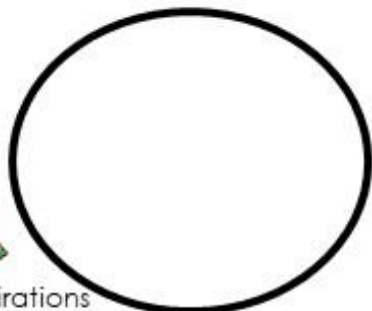

Age Range: All ages

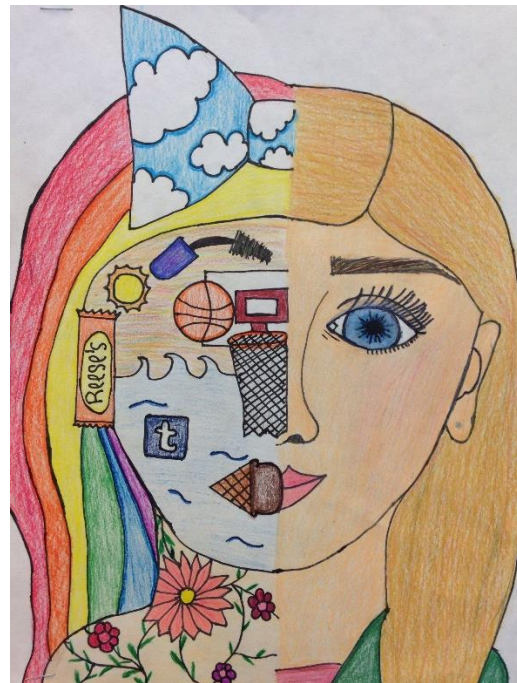
Half Photo, Half Art

Age Range: All ages

Supplies: Picture of each child, cut in half, crayons or markers, paper.

Set Up: Take a photo of each child in your group have it about 8 ½ x 11 to fit on a piece of paper. Cut the photo in half.

Instructions: Give each child their photo and have them glue it to one half of a piece of paper. Next have each child draw the other half of their face. If they do not want to draw their own face, they can make it something fun they like (ex: spider man, princess, favorite animal, etc).

Marble Painting Apples

Age Range: All ages

Supplies: Apple coloring page, marbles, paint, marble painting boxes, scissors.

Set Up: Print out an apple coloring page.

Instructions: Give each child an apple coloring page, have them cut it out. Place the apple in the marble art box. Let the children choose which colors they want on their apple. Dip the marble in the paint, place in the marble art box, roll the marble around and decorate the apple. Let them use as many colors as they would like.
