

## **Outdoor Activities**

Shark

Age Range: All Ages

Supplies: Cones, hula hoops

<u>Set Up:</u> Set up the cones in a large square.

<u>Instructions:</u> The game begins when the music starts, have the children walk clockwise around the ocean. At some point after about 10-15 seconds, you yell SHARK! Once the students hear that they must enter into the ocean and look for safety on an ice berg (hula hoops). There can be many students on an ice berg. As long as there are no students in the ocean, the class has survived the first shark sighting.

Send students back to the ocean and grab a few icebergs from the middle. Music continues until you yell SHARK again, students are helping each other to safety, this time with less icebergs. If everyone makes it, let them know they have survived 2 shark sightings.

Continue removing icebergs making the students share resources even more and having to lend extra support to keep everyone safe. At some point they won't be able to get everyone on and therefore you declare hoe many shark sightings they have successfully survived, but the shark has finally stuck. Replace the icebergs and play again if time permits.
