



## Outdoor Activities

### Spider Web Tag

Age Range: All Ages

Supplies: Chalk

Set Up: On a basketball court or large playing area, draw a large spider web.

Instructions: Choose two players to be spiders. All other players are flies caught in the spider web and must sit somewhere on the web. The flies cannot get up until tagged. The goal of the two spiders is to “capture” as many flies as they can and free them from the web before the other spider tags them. Have both spiders start on opposite sides of the spider web, on “go” the spiders can only walk on the lines of the web, they will “free” each fly they approach by tagging them. The flies go to where the spider started and are now “points” for that spider. The spiders are trying to free as many flies as they can while also trying to tag the other spider. The spider with the most flies at the end wins!
